Singles by numbers

- Loneliness is the biggest cause of stress for singles, with more people worrying about their solo status than by credit card debt, work pressures and global financial crisis.
- Men benefit much more than women do from being in a relationship: scientific studies have shown that married men live longer and enjoy better physical and mental health compared to their single counterparts.
- In Cyprus in 2009, with a population of around 850,000, there were:
 - 6,327 marriages, up from 6,115 the year before (over 2,000 of which were by visiting tourists)
 - 1,738 divorces, up from 1,639 the year before
- The number of one-person households worldwide reached 202.6 million in 2006, up from 153.5 million in 1996
- In the US, almost 40 per cent of the single population is divorced, while about 60 per cent has never been married before.
- A recent study found that sociable singles score high on happiness scales. Just having friends and a strong career make a difference. Isolation is what's detrimental.
